- By accepting these Terms and Conditions you warrant that the information which you submit and/or distribute will not infringe the intellectual property, privacy or any other rights of any third party, and will not contain anything which is libellous, defamatory, obscene, indecent, harassing or threatening.
- If relevant, the ERC reserves the right, but not the obligation, to screen, filter and/or monitor information provided by you and to edit, refuse to distribute or remove it.
- By accepting these Terms and Conditions, you warrant that all information submitted by you is true, current and complete.
- In consideration of the ERC agreeing to consider entrants to the Competition - by accepting these Terms and Conditions - each entrant assigns to the ERC the complete copyright and all other rights in any entry, which shall be for the full period of copyright. The ERC shall be free to assign such rights to third parties.
- Prize winners shall be notified 1-2 weeks after the competition deadline.
